Flowers are used to communicate our most profound emotions to one another; they serve as heralds of the seasons. One becomes keenly aware of the cycle of life as you observe flowers – budding, then brilliant, heavy with perfection as they wither slowly with seeming intent. The beauty of her flowers celebrates glorious life while subtly reminding us of the fleeting nature of our own existence. Florez says, "I am unknowing today of where my own exploration of beauty will take me, but I look to flowers as graceful guides on that journey.

Sandra is a formally trained visual artist from Texas and has currently been continuing her visual work through painting. She has been selected for group exhibitions in Texas, Chicago, SOHO NY.
